We are delighted that your student has shown an interest in being a manager for the Weiss Scarlets Dance Team for the 2024-2025 school year. As a parent of a prospective dance team manager, you should be fully aware of the application procedure and requirements. You and your son or daughter must also realize the commitment and dedication required of dance team managers.

Being a manager of our organization provides an important opportunity for self-development and leadership, as well as dependability, responsibility, self-discipline and life-long memories. You're going to work hard, and you're also going to have a lot of fun!

Managers are required to enroll in at least one Scarlets class period. These students will receive the appropriate dance or PE credit. This is a requirement, and the students must have room in their schedule to allow for this condition. It is up to the student as to whether they double-block Scarlets or not.

The application procedure requires that candidates complete the application no later than Tuesday, February 27th at 4:30 pm. Students should fill out the application BY HAND and either turn in their hard copy or scan/take a photo and email it to the email addresses below. Interviews will happen in person on February 28th and 29th.

The next pages will familiarize you with the general information concerning the expectations, time commitment, and cost of being a Scarlets manager. Being selected as a dance team manager is a great opportunity, and it requires a tremendous commitment. You are just as much a part of the team as the Scarlet dancers are. There are countless rewards and privileges from being a Scarlets manager, and while there are many responsibilities, there are also tons of fun experiences! It is important that everyone understands and agrees to what is expected throughout the manager application and interview process.
